Parents and carers may be aware that there are fewer buses available to transport students to local schools. Schools are working with the local authority to make them aware how important this issue is to parents, carers and schools.

The problem maybe the allocation of funds since the end of the Covid transport funding. Parents and schools are being advised to use public transport via the Chester Bus Interchange. We understand this brings inconvenience, longer journey times and worry for parents and students.

Directing hundred's of students to one place is not a long term solution and schools and parents are concerned about the number of seats and services available.

We need your help, if your child is experiencing issues travelling to and from school due to the recent cancellation and changes to bus routes we ask that you make contact either with your local MP, Local Councillor or go direct to Cheshire West and Chester Transport Services. It is important that any issues are raised and reported correctly to ensure there is a proper understanding of the effects the recent changes to local transport have had to the community.
