

Summer School – HARmony Camp



Our Summer School 'HARmony Camp', took place over 5 days in the School Summer Holidays, running from Monday 26th – Friday 30th July 2021. Our summer HARmony Campy focussed on the themes of **H**onesty, **A**wareness and **R**espect through a blend of academic and enrichment opportunities.

The Summer School was open to all of our incoming Year 6 Students (with approximately 155 students attending each day), as well as students in Years 8, 9 and 10 (with approximately 40 students attending each day) who had trained to become 'Heroes' – role models and leaders for the camp.

Students experienced a range of workshops led by our Staff, our partners at **Human Uptopia** by our students. The HARmony Camp provided an opportunity for students to make new friends, to get to know older students, to familiarise themselves with the ethos of our school as well as exploring and developing skills in a variety of curriculum areas.
